ABOUT ADI KAILASH & OMPARVAT



Adi Kailash and Om Parvat, located in the Kumaon region of Uttarakhand, are two of the most revered spiritual destinations in India. Adi Kailash, also known as Chhota Kailash, is considered a sacred replica of Mount Kailash in Tibet and is associated with Lord Shiva. Standing at an altitude of approximately 6,191 meters, it is surrounded by divine sites like Parvati Sarovar and Gauri Kund, where devotees offer prayers and seek blessings. Om Parvat, on the other hand, is renowned for its naturally occurring 'Om' (ॐ) symbol, which is formed by the unique alignment of snow and rock on the mountain. At an altitude of 5,590 meters, it holds deep spiritual significance for Hindus, Buddhists, and Jains. The journey to these sacred peaks is a mesmerizing blend of devotion and adventure, passing through scenic landscapes, glaciers, and remote villages like Dharchula, Gunji, and Kutti. Pilgrims and trekkers undertake this expedition not only to witness the breathtaking beauty of the Himalayas but also to experience the divine energy and serenity these sites offer.

- **DAY -1** New Delhi to Tanakpur (335 Kms)
- **DAY -2** Tanakpur to Dharchula (235 Kms)
- **DAY -3** Dharchula to Gunji (56 Km)
- **DAY -4** Gunji to Adi Kailash and back to Gunji
- **DAY -5** Gunji to Om Parvat, Lipulekh Pass, and back to Dharchula
- **DAY -6** Dharchula to Patal Bhuvneshwar
- **DAY -7** Patal Bhuvneshwar to Haldwani via Jageshwar
- **DAY -8** Haldwani to Delhi



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DAY 1



DELHI TO TANAKPUR

- **Distance:** Approximately 350–400 km (around 9–10 hours by road)
- **Route:** The journey starts early from Delhi, heading towards the Himalayan foothills of Uttarakhand. The route generally goes through NH9, passing through Moradabad, Rudrapur, and Haldwani before reaching Tanakpur.
- **Highlights:** Scenic Journey: As you leave the plains and enter the foothills, you'll see the change in landscape from flat terrain to the first glimpses of the mountains.
- **Tanakpur:** Tanakpur is a small town situated in the Champawat district of Uttarakhand, close to the Nepal border. The town is peaceful, and it's a good spot to relax after a long drive. It's situated near the Kali River, which makes the environment serene.
- **Overnight:** Stay in Tanakpur and prepare for the next day's travel to Dharchula.



DAY 2



TANAKPUR TO DHARCHULA

- Distance:** Distance: About 80-100 km (4-5 hours)
- Route:** From Tanakpur, the road will take you along narrow mountain roads towards Dharchula. The journey involves winding roads, and you'll gradually climb higher into the mountains.
- Highlights:** Scenic Beauty: As you ascend, the natural beauty of Uttarakhand unfolds. You'll see lush green forests, rivers, and small villages perched on hillsides.
- Dharchula:** This is a picturesque hill station located near the border with Nepal. It is known for its tranquil surroundings and provides a great base for further travels. The town itself is small, with several temples and local markets. Dharchula is a key stop for travelers heading to the Indo-Tibetan region, including the sacred Adi Kailash and Om Parvat.



DAY 3



DHARCHULA TO GUNJI

- ◉ **Distance:** Approximately 60–70 km (5–6 hours)
- **Route:** The road to Gunji from Dharchula is even more rugged, with some sections requiring careful navigation. The region is sparsely populated, and the journey is marked by picturesque valleys, rivers, and dense forests.
- **Highlights: Gunji:** Gunji is a small village located at a higher altitude (about 3,200 meters), and it is considered a key stopover for pilgrims going to Adi Kailash and Om Parvat. The village offers beautiful views of the surrounding snow-covered peaks. It's also a place to acclimatize before heading to even higher altitudes.



DAY 4



GUNJI TO ADI KAILASH AND BACK TO GUNJI

- Distance: 25–30 km one way (trekking involved)
- Route: The trek to Adi Kailash is a high-altitude journey, so it's essential to be well-prepared. This is a challenging trek that involves ascending from Gunji to the Adi Kailash temple, which is situated at around 4,400 meters above sea level.
- Highlights:
 - Adi Kailash: This is a revered place of worship and is considered the smaller twin of the Mount Kailash in Tibet. It holds great spiritual significance for Hindus. The sacred mountain and the surrounding landscape are breathtaking, with panoramic views of the snow-capped peaks.
 - Back to Gunji: After spending time at Adi Kailash, you'll return to Gunji, where you can rest and recover from the challenging trek.



DAY 5



GUNJI TO OM PARVAT, LIPULEKH PASS, AND BACK TO DHARCHULA

- **Distance:** 40–50 km one way (trekking and high-altitude driving involved)

Route: This day involves a more strenuous journey as you will trek or drive towards Om Parvat and then visit the Lipulekh Pass. Both are situated at high altitudes and require good physical preparation.

- **Highlights:**

- **Om Parvat:** Om Parvat is known for the natural formation of snow on its slopes, which resembles the Hindu sacred symbol "Om." It is a revered site for spiritual pilgrims. The mountain is located at around 5,000 meters above sea level, so the trek to Om Parvat is challenging and requires careful acclimatization.
- **Lipulekh Pass:** Lipulekh Pass is an ancient trade route between India and Tibet, located at an altitude of about 5,300 meters. It is a strategic border pass and also holds spiritual significance. The pass is famous for its Breathtaking views and historical relevance in the pilgrimages to Kailash Mansarovar.
- **Return to Dharchula:** After visiting Om Parvat and Lipulekh Pass, you will return to Dharchula for the night.



DAY 6



DHARCHULA TO PATAL BHUVNESHWAR

- ◉ **Distance:** Approximately 100–120 km (5–6 hours) **Route:** The
- road to Patal Bhuvneshwar is a scenic journey, and as you drive through the mountains, you'll pass through small villages and green valleys. The road becomes a bit challenging, especially if the weather is not favorable.
- **Highlights:**
- ◉ **Patal Bhuvneshwar:** This is a sacred cave complex dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in the Bageshwar district. The caves are believed to have been formed by the Pandavas during their exile. The temple complex is known for its narrow chambers, with many underground shrines and idols of gods and goddesses.
- **Overnight:** Stay in Patal Bhuvneshwar or nearby towns.



PATAL BHUVNESHWAR TO HALDWANI VIA JAGESHWAR

- ◉ **Distance:** Around 150–170 km (5–6 hours)
- **Route:** The journey from Patal Bhuvneshwar to Kathgodam will take you through narrow mountain roads. On the way, you will stop at Jageshwar, another important religious site.
- **Highlights:**
 - **Jageshwar:** This is an ancient temple complex dedicated to Lord Shiva, located in a beautiful deodar forest. The temples are believed to be over 1,500 years old and are one of the 12 Jyotirlingas in India. The setting is tranquil and perfect for some reflection.
 - **Kathgodam:** After visiting Jageshwar, you will proceed towards Kathgodam, which is the gateway to Nainital and the Kumaon region. Kathgodam is a bustling town, and from here, you can catch a bus or train back to Delhi.



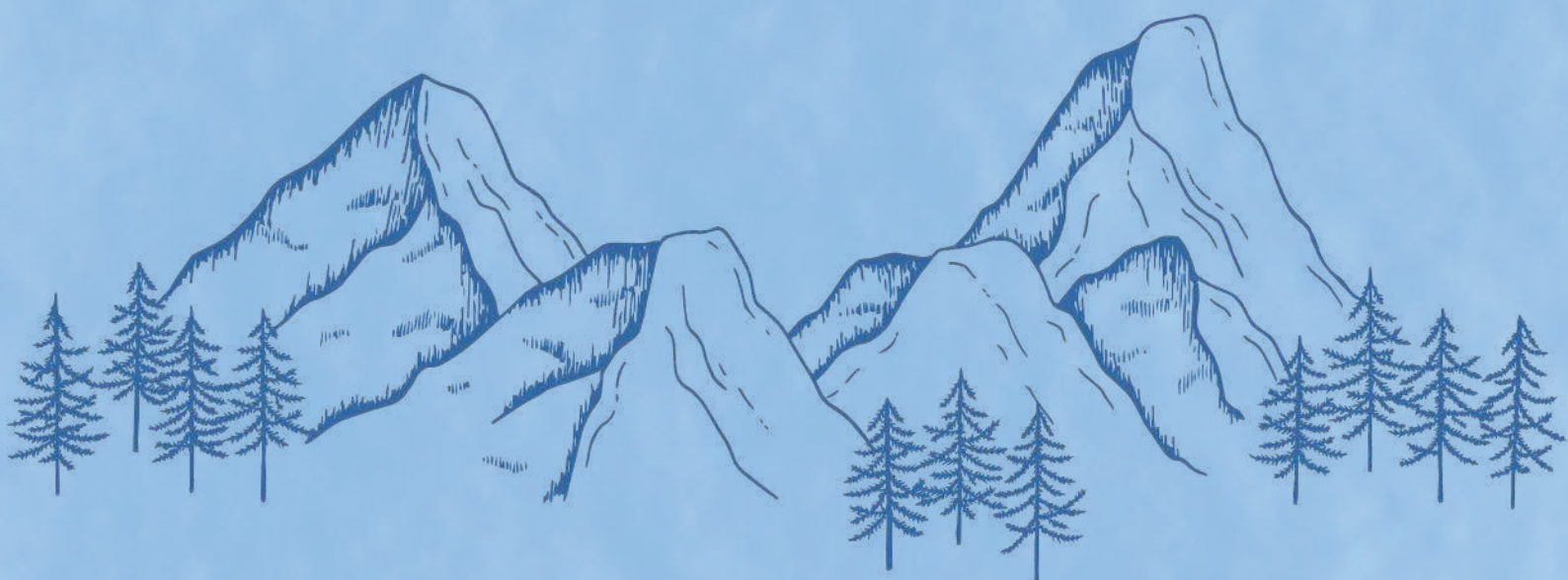
HALDWANI TO DELHI

- **Distance:** Around 150–170 km (5–6 hours) **Route:**
- **After breakfast, drive back from Haldwani to Delhi**
The road journey passes through the scenic Kumaon region, offering beautiful mountain views, winding roads, and peaceful landscapes as you gradually descend from the hills into the plains.
- **Highlights:** Return to Delhi: The return to Delhi marks the end of your adventurous journey. Depending on the time you reach Delhi, you can relax and unwind after the long trip.



GENERAL TIPS FOR THE TRIP

- **Acclimatization:** Since you'll be traveling at high altitudes (above 3,500 meters), it's crucial to give your body time to adjust to the thinner air. Drink plenty of water and avoid strenuous activities on the first day at higher altitudes.
- **Packing:** Pack light but carry essentials like warm clothing, rain gear, trekking shoes, a first-aid kit, and essential medications.
- **Permits:** Make sure you have the required permits for traveling in restricted areas near the border (especially for places like Lipulekh Pass).
- **Weather:** Check the weather conditions frequently, as the region can experience sudden changes in weather, particularly during the monsoon or winter seasons.

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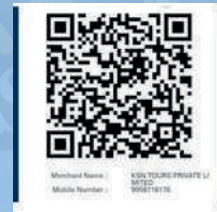


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PAYMENT POLICY
